

# Radio Changes Approved At Orangeburg, Columbia

Washington, May 10—(AP)—Radio Station WTND of Orangeburg, S. C., applied to the communications commission today to change its frequency from 1270 to 920 kilocycles.

The commission authorized WMSC at Columbia, S. C., to increase its night power from 500 watts to one kilowatt and authorized John J. Powell to sell the license of Radio Station WANS at Anderson, S. C., to Carolina Broadcasters for \$85,000.
