

WMSC Again Wins Safety Council Honor

Radio Station WMSC, Columbia, was announced as one of the recipients of the National Safety Council's 1955 Public Interest Award.

The noncompetitive award is made annually to public information media for exceptional service to safety. The 1955 award went to 108 radio stations in the country, 34 television stations, 32 daily newspapers and 10 weekly newspapers.

WMSC is the only radio station in South Carolina to receive the award—the second successive year the Columbia station has been so honored.
