

# Olive Named Assistant to City Manager

Graydon V. ("Gray") Olive, Jr., immediate past president of the Columbia Junior Chamber of Commerce, has been appointed administrative assistant to Columbia's city manager, City Manager WMSC, will assume his new yesterday.
